<b>Section 4:</b>	<b>FIRST AID MEASURES</b>
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**Symptoms/Effects:**

- Acute:** Eye contact may cause eye irritation. Repeated or prolonged skin contact may cause skin irritation. Ingestion may irritate the gastrointestinal tract.
- Chronic:** No known chronic effects.
- Eyes:** Immediately flush with large quantities of water for 15 minutes. Hold eyelids apart during irrigation to ensure thorough flushing of the entire area of the eye and lids. Take victim to an ophthalmologist.
- Skin:** Immediately flush with large quantities of water. Remove contaminated clothing under a safety shower. Continue rinsing. Obtain medical attention if irritation occurs.
- Ingestion:** If victim is conscious, give 2 to 4 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat. Obtain medical attention.
- Inhalation:** Remove victim from contaminated atmosphere. If breathing is labored, administer oxygen. If breathing has ceased, clear airway and start CPR. Obtain medical attention.

**Specific Hazards Arising from the Chemical:**

**Physical Hazards:** Heating (flames) of closed or sealed containers may cause violent rupture of container due to thermal expansion of compressed gases.

**Protective Equipment and Precautions for Firefighters:**

Firefighters should wear self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) and full fire-fighting turnout gear. Keep containers/storage vessels in fire area cooled with water spray.

<b>Section 6: ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES</b>
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**Personal Precautions:** Use personal protective equipment specified in Section 8. Isolate the hazard area and deny entry to unnecessary, untrained and unprotected personnel.

**Environmental Precautions:** Keep out of "waters of the United States" because of potential aquatic toxicity.

**Methods of Containment:**

**Small Release:** Confine and absorb small releases with sand, earth or other inert absorbents.

**Large Release:** Shut off release if safe to do so. Dike spill area with earth, sand or other inert absorbents to prevent runoff into surface waterways (potential aquatic toxicity), storm drains.

**Methods for Cleanup:**

**Small Release:** Shovel up the absorbed material and place in drums for disposal as a chemical waste or recycle as a fertilizer as the original product was intended.

**Large Release:** Recover as much of the spilled product as possible using portable pump and hoses. Use recovered material as originally intended or dispose of as a chemical waste. Treat remaining material as a small release (above).

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**Handling:** Avoid contact with eyes. Use only in a well-ventilated area. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with the skin.

**Storage:** Store in well-ventilated areas. Do not store combustibles in the area of storage vessels. Keep away from any sources of heat or flame. Store totes and smaller containers out of direct sunlight at moderate temperatures. (See Section 10.5 for materials of construction.)
